Common name

Norfolk Island Pine

Family

Araucariaceae

Where found

Planted as an ornamental. Gardens and roadsides. Coastal and Sydney area inland from the coast.

Native to Norfolk Island.

Notes

Introduced tree to 70 m tall. Bark peeling in thin flakes. **Juvenile** leaves 1–1.25 cm long, transitioning into mature leaves. Mature leaves in overlapping series encircling the stems, 0.4–0.7 cm long, 3–6 mm wide. Male **cones** single, 4–5 cm long, 1–1.3 cm diameter. Female cones 7.5–10 cm long, 8–10 cm diameter, in small groups. Mature cones 100–120 mm long and 120–140 mm in diameter.
