Family

Rutaceae

Where found

Along streams. Ranges north from west of Wollongong to Wollemi National Park.

Notes

Shrub to 1.5 m high. Young branches grey to brown **stellate**-hairy (needs a hand lens or a macro app on your phone/tablet to see). Leaves aromatic when rubbed, **alternating** up the stems, 1–2.5 cm long, 2–3 mm wide, tip blunt, margins slightly curved down, upper surface with scattered stellate hairs, lower surface brownish stellate-hairy. Flowers yellow, outer surface rusty stellate-hairy, with 5 **petals** each about 6 mm long. Flowers in 1–3 flowered clusters.
