Common name

Grand Collomia, Large-flowered Collomia, Large-flowered Phlox, Large-flowered Mountain Trumpet

Family

Polemoniaceae

Where found

Disturbed areas. Kosciuszko National Park and the western edge of the ACT on the NSW side.

Notes

Introduced annual herb to about 1 m high, more or less hairy. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 3–7 cm long, 6–15 mm wide, margins usually **entire**, tips pointed. Flowers buff or salmon-pink, about 25 mm long, narrowly funnel-shaped with 5 **spreading** lobes each about 5 mm long. **Calyx** sticky hairy. Flowers in **head**-like clusters. Flowering: summer.
