Asteraceae

Where found

Mallee, woodland, pastures, and exposed places. Western Slopes.

Notes

Annual herb to 0.16 m tall. Stems hairless or sparsely hairy. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 0.3-1.8 cm long, less than 1 mm wide, flattened cylindrical, sparsely hairy to hairless. Flower **heads** orange to yellow, with papery '**petals**' each 2-5 mm long. Flower heads cup-shaped or hemispherical below the '**petals**', 8-15 mm in diameter. Flower heads single.
