Notes

Palm like plant. Seeds with a fleshy outer layer. Stem subterranean. Leaves basal, 3–10 in the **crown**, 110–150 cm long. **Rachis** not twisted to moderately twisted, leaflets 90–140, grey-green, semi-glossy, longest leaflets 22–31 cm long, 9–14 mm wide; basal leaflets not reduced to spines. Male and female **cones** on different plants. Cones 160–320 mm long, spines on male cones 0–1 cm long, spines on female cones 2.5.5 cm long. Seeds red when ripe.
