Common name

Minnie Daisy

Family

Asteraceae

Where found

Dry **forest**, **woodland**, **shrubland**, and **grassland**. Western Slopes. Occasionally elsewhere.

Notes

Perennial herb or **shrub**, to 0.5 m tall or sprawling. Stems sparsely hairy, finally hairless. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 0.5-4 cm long, 0.5-1 mm wide, hairy to almost hairless, margins **entire**, tips pointed. Flower **heads** with many white, pink, or mauve to purple '**petals**', each 4-9 mm long, and yellow centres. Flower heads bell-shaped below the '**petals**'. Flower heads single. Flowers throughout the year.
