Common name

Lilac Lily

Family

Colchicaceae

Where found

Forest, shrubland, and moist sites. Coast and ranges.

Notes

Perennial herb to 0.20 m high or sprawling to **prostrate**, hairless. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 1.5–5 cm long, 7–18 mm wide, tips more or less pointed, bases tapering, margins wavy. Flowers pink to mauve, with 6 '**petals**', each 7–12 mm long. Flowers single or in few-flowered clusters. Flowers Spring.
