Where found

Garden **escape**. Sydney area north from Camden, and north.

Notes

Introduced shrub to about 1.5 m high. Branchlets hairy to hairless. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 2–8 cm long, 7–20 mm wide, margins toothed, surfaces hairless, sometimes the lower surface hairy, upper surface dark green, lower surface bluish. Flowers white, with 5 **petals** each 2.5–4 mm long. Flowers in many-flowered clusters. Flowers spring.

Family was Malaceae.
