## Common name

## Family

Chenopodiaceae

## Where found

Salt marshes on the Parramatta River, Sydney area.

## Notes

**Shrub** or **perennial** herb to about 1 m tall or sprawling. Fleshy stems, flowers, and the **bracts** around the flowers. Seed cases fleshy, spongy, or papery with a pithy interior. Stems dull or **glaucous**. Leafless. Flowers bisexual, or some plants with only female flowers. Flowers tiny (less than 3 mm in diameter), with 2 lobes, forming **spikes** to 5 cm long.
