## Asplenium simplicifrons

### Family:

Aspleniaceae

### Botanical name

*Asplenium simplicifrons* F.Muell.

### Common name:

Narrow-Leaf Birds-Nest Fern

### Description

Epiphytic on tree trunks and buttresses or lithophytic on boulders in high-rainfall vine forest.

Usually a subcanopy epiphyte in lower semi-shaded strata of forest canopy.

### Distribution

Endemic to NE QLD from Mt Finnegan to the Eungella.

### Habit and habitat

Epiphytic on tree trunks and buttresses or lithophytic on boulders in high-rainfall vine forest.

Usually a subcanopy epiphyte in lower strata.

### Natural history

An attractive horticultural fern.

### Cultivation

Readily cultivated in a container of coarse free draining material or on rocks or a tree in a shaded tropical garden or fernery. This species requires more regular watering and higher humidity than *Asplenium nidus* and *A. australasicum*. It is particularly susceptible to white-scale.
