Drypteridaceae

### Common name:

Broad shield fern

### Description

Rhizome erect, 2–5 mm thick, scaly at the apex; scales 1–2.5 mm long, 0.3–0.5 mm wide, brown to blackish. Fronds crowded. Stipe 10–22 cm long, thin, scaly at the base. Lamina 3–4-pinnate, ovate to narrowly triangular, 10–25 cm long, 6–25 cm wide, pale green, glossy, finely dissected, thin, glabrous except on the veins; rachises sparsely hairy. Ultimate segments linear to spatulate, c. 1 mm wide, obtuse, widely spaced; margins entire. Sori almost terminal on veinlets, 1 per ultimate segment, exindusiate.

### Distribution

Endemic to NE QLD, restricted to Carbine Tableland, Mt Bartle Frere, Tinaroo Hills and Lamb Range.

### Habit and habitat

Terrestrial or lithophytic, usually on rocks in small creeks in dense montane rainforest.
