

Plants of South Eastern New South Wales

Common name

Greenish-flower Vanilla-lily

Family

Asparagaceae

Where found

Variety of **habitats**, including dry **forest**, **woodland**, and rocky situations. Mostly coast and ranges. Occasional elsewhere.

Notes

Perennial herb to 1 m tall. Leaves basal, 3–40 cm long, 1–10 mm wide, bright green. Flowers with 6 '**petals**' each 4–6 mm long, greenish pink. '**Petals**' bent back. **Filaments** of the **stamens** with dense white hairs. **Anthers** white to pale green. Flowers usually 1–9 per **node**. Flowering chiefly November–February.
