Cunoniaceae

Where found

Wet **heath** on deep sand. Coastal areas north from Royal National Park.

Notes

Shrub to 0.3 m high. Leaves opposite each other, appearing **simple** and **whorled**. Leaves **compound**, with 3 leaflets each 0.3–0.7 cm long, 1–2 mm wide, usually lobed on one or both margins. Flowers deep pink, with 4 **petals** each about 6 mm long. Flowers more or less stalkless. **Stamens** pink. Flowering: summer.

Family was Baueraceae.
