Common name

Pale Beauty Heads

Family

Asteraceae

Where found

Woodland, shrubland, grassland, and sites subject to flooding. Western Slopes.

Notes

Annual herb to 0.5 m tall. Stems **woolly**, grey to silvery. Leaves highly aromatic when rubbed, **alternating** up the stems, sometimes the lowermost opposite each other, 0.5-6.3 cm long, 2-5 mm wide, hairy, often dilated and sheathing at the base or the bases of the leaves continuing down the stems, tips pointed. Flower **heads** yellow to yellow-orange or white, 6-12 mm long, **compound**, with about 50-100 individual flower heads, round to oval, with 0 **petals**, single at the tops of the stems. Flowering: spring-summer.
