Jade Plant

Family

Crassulaceae

Where found

Garden **escape**. North of Wollongong.

Notes

Introduced shrublike **perennial** herb to 1.5 m high. Stems and leaves fleshy. Leaves opposite each other, 2–4 cm long, 10–22 mm wide, green, often with red margins, the leaves of each pair united at the base to form a ridge round the stem, tips pointed or blunt with a distinct **mucro**. Flowers white tinged pink, with 5 **petals** each 5–10 mm long, shortly fused at the base. Flowers clustered. Flowers Jun.–Aug.
