Common name

Slender celery

Family

Apiaceae

Where found

Pastures; gardens, roadsides, and other disturbed areas. Widespread, mainly in the Sydney region.

Notes

Introduced annual herb to 0.7 m tall. Stems hairless. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 2–10 cm long, **compound**, with 3–4 threadlike leaflets. Flowers with 5 white **petals** about 0.3 mm long, in few to many-flowered clusters. Flowers throughout the year but mainly Oct.–Jan.
