Apiaceae

Where found

Subalpine and alpine **herbfields** adjacent to bogs and streams. Snowy Mountains.

Notes

Perennial herb to 0.45 m high, hairless. Strong aniseed odour when rubbed. Leaves mostly basal, 10-25 cm long including the leaf stalk, basal **sheath** to 4.5 cm long. Leaves **compound**, with 9-13 leaflets each 0.8-4 cm long, 7-12 mm wide, margins toothed, surfaces hairless. A few stem leaves **alternating** up the stems, smaller. Flowers about 2-2.5 mm in diameter, with 5 white **petals**, and tiny pink **anthers**, in open clusters.
