## Family

Haloragaceae

## Where found

Open forest, heath, rocky areas, and stream banks. Blue Mountains National Park.

## Notes

Shrub to 1 m high, hairless. Stems 4 -angled to narrowly winged. Leaves opposite each other, 1.5-2.8 cm long, 2-6 mm wide, margins toothed with reddish teeth. Flowers with 4 cream petals each $6-14 \mathrm{~mm}$ long. Flowers single. Seed cases more or less oval, weakly 4 -angled and with a few coarse protuberances in the lower half, $4.5-5 \mathrm{~mm}$ long and $2.5-4 \mathrm{~mm}$ broad.
