Family

Haloragaceae

Where found

Open **forest**, **heath**, rocky areas, and stream banks. Blue Mountains National Park.

Notes

Shrub to 1 m high, hairless. Stems 4-angled to narrowly **winged**. Leaves opposite each other, 1.5-2.8 cm long, 2-6 mm wide, margins toothed with reddish teeth. Flowers with 4 cream **petals** each 6-14 mm long. Flowers single. Seed cases more or less oval, weakly 4-angled and with a few coarse protuberances in the lower half, 4.5-5 mm long and 2.5-4 mm broad.
