Common name

None

Family

Haloragaceae

Where found

Forest and **heath**. Ranges and tablelands south from near Nerriga. Rarely elsewhere.

Notes

Shrub to 2 m high, hairless. Stems 4-ribbed. Leaves opposite each other, **adult** leaves 1–1.8 cm long, 1–3 mm wide, margins obscurely toothed in the upper half. **Juvenile** leaves **dissected**. Flowers with 4 cream, sometimes tinged pink, **petals**, each 4.5–6 mm long. Flowers in subclusters of up to 7 flowers, 12–14 subclusters making up the **compound** cluster. Flowers Spring to Summer. Seed cases more or less pyramidal, with 4 narrow **wings**, 3–5 mm long, 1.5–2 mm in diameter.
