Common name

Slender lagenophora

Family

Asteraceae

Where found

Moist gullies and near water. Widespread.

Notes

Perennial herb with a short **rhizome**. Flower stalks hairless, or sparsely **appressed** hairy below the flower **heads**, to 0.35 m high. Leaves basal, 1–8 cm long, 6–20 mm wide, margins wavy to toothed with pointed or blunt teeth, sparsely hairy to more or less hairless. Flower heads with '**petals**' 1.5–2.5 mm long, white or mauve to purple, and yellow centres 3–4 mm in diameter. Flower heads behind the '**petals**' 1.5–2.5 mm long. Flower heads single. Flowering: spring–summer.

Was *Lagenifera gracilis*.
