Common name

A geebung

Family

Proteaceae

Where found

Dry **forest** and **heath**. Gosford area south to Frenchs Forest.

Notes

Shrub to 1.5 m high. Fruit fleshy. Bark smooth. Young branchlets sparsely hairy with greyish hairs. Leaves **alternating** up the stems, 1.2–3 cm long, about 0.5 mm wide, cylindrical, hairless, tips often curved. Flowers with 4 yellow '**petals**' each 7–8 mm long, more or less fused at the base, sparsely hairy or hairless. Flowers **erect** to **spreading**, mostly **subtended** by full-sized leaves, in mostly 10–70-flowered clusters. Flowers Jan.–July.

Very occasionally hybridises with *Persoonia pinifolia*.

Protected NSW.
