## Breadfruit leaf blotch (323)

---

### Summary

- Narrow distribution. Only on breadfruit. Minor fungal disease.
- Leaf spots absent; dingy dark-brown to blackish sooty mould on lower surface of leaf. Spores are spread in the wind.
- Cultural control: none
- Chemical control: none

*Pseudocercospora artocarpicola*
