Kangkong leaf spot (206)

Summary

- Worldwide. In the tropics. On kangkong and relatives, mostly weeds. It has been reported on sweetpotato. A minor disease of old leaves.
- Light brown spots with black borders, round to irregular, up to 5 mm. Centres sometimes fall out.
- Cultural control: none recommended.
- Chemical control: none recommended.

Kangkong leaf spot

Scientific Name

Cercospora ipomoeae; also recorded as *Cercospora bataticola*.
