

Na Mate Ni Bean (043)

Kena I Vakamacala

- E kune na mate oqo e vuravura taucoko. E kune ena co kedra na manumanu, vuvale ni bean, co ca me vaka na qaradila (wild passionfruit) ka vakalailaitaka na tatamusuki.
- Vakavuna na kena sega ni tubu vinaka ni tei kei na bulitaki vakaca ni drauna (stunted & distorted). Vakadewataka na manumanu meca (aphids) kei na sore ni tei.
- **Tataqomaki Taumada (Cultural control):** Digitaka nai tei vinaka me teivaki; kakua ni teivaka nai tei vou volekata nai teitei makawa; me veicurumaki nai tei ni bean kei na sila; vakayagataka nai tei vorata na mate (resistant variety); kumuna ka vakama na benu ni tei ni oti na tatamusuki.
- **Wainimate ni Tatarovi:** Na vakayagataki ni wainimate e sega ni walewale vinaka ni kena vakamatei na manumanu meca (aphids).

Common name: Bean common mosaic, common mosaic of beans

Scientific name: The abbreviation of the virus is BCMV.
