- **Faaogaina o vaila'au:** i totonu o fale, PDPs e togafitia ai le fili fa'alafua (polo feu I lona fua fautuaina, ao faatoaga faapisinisi, fa'aoga le Bt (*Bacillus thuringiensis*) ia fa'aeteete I vailaau oona.
