- O faasalalau e afiti.
- I luga o le kava, su'e lau mimigi, o lo'o i ai fasi kosi samasama po'o pa'apa'e i veni; 'oti' au e su'e pe maua ai laina enaena i totonu, ma 'au pala uliuli e gaui gofie.
- **Metotia fa'ale-agantu'u:** totō ese mai isi 'ava i 'ele'ele lafulemu lelei ile paolo; si'o le fanua I laau e pei o, fa'i, *bele*, manioka, citrus, esi, suka; totō ni ava i totonu o le fale faamili e siaki ai pe leai ni fa'ama'i; vao; a alia'e loa se fa'ama'i gagau ese le pito fa'amaia mai i luga a'e o le palapala. Afai o le laau e ititi ifo i le 1-tausaga le matua, sui le laau.
