

## Lago Faalafua I Samoa (Samoa fruit flies) (169)

### Aotelega

- *Bactrocera kirki* – E aafia ai laau e pei o le *apiu*, avoka, kuava, mago, nonu ma isi laau.
- *Bactrocera xanthodes* - *apiu*, avoka, ulu, esi, sasalapa ma isi laau. O nei lago e lua, e taua tele i le faataua I le tamaoaiga ma le faatauaina o laau taumafai mata pei ona taua I luga. O lona tolu, *Bactrocera distincta*, e tele ina aafia ai le laau o le apu lanu viole (star apple, *Chrysophyllum cainito*).
- E mana'omia tele se puipuiga a'o le'i tu'u fuamoa o nei lago e tolu.
- **O Togafitiga fa'aleaganu'u:** ia totō nei fualaau taumafamata aua nei latalata i fualauaina faisua pei o tamato, isalaelu, green pepper ma isi laau, Ia ao mai fua ua pauu ma faaumatia I se afi pe tanu foi I le palapala, ia vave ona selesele pei o le (papaya, polo feu, poo le fala samoa foi, ia aua nei faaleagaina e nei lago I luga o le laau pea tuai ona tau.
- **O le Puleaina o vaila'au:** e mafai ona fa'aaoga puipuiga tuufaatasi, fa'ata'ita'iga MPPIL Royal Tongalure po'o Bactrogel.e tuu I totonu o mailei ia tapue ai nei lago ma ave e faatamaia I se malaia faaoga ai mailei pei ona fautuaina.

**Igoa masani:** E fitu ituaiga o lago fualaau aina i Samoa. O lago faalafua e lua e taua tele mo le tamaoaiga o laau faisua. *Bactrocera kirki* (leai se igoa masani) ma le lago faalafua o le Pasefika (*Bactrocera xanthodes*), lona tolu, *Bactrocera distincta* o lo'o i totonu po'o fa'ama'i o le apu lanu viole - star apple).

O igoa nei: *Bactrocera paraxanthodes* i Niu Kaletonia, ma *Bactrocera neoxanthodes* i Vanuatu, ma se ituaiga e lei oo mai i Samoa.

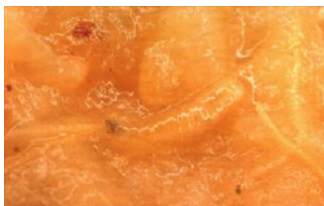
