- O le maualuga o le vevela ma le timu e fiafia i fa'ama'i. O siama e poloka ai paipa e tafe ai le vai e mafua ai le pala.
- Tuu le ogalaaui tipi i totonu o le vai e iloa ai le 'tafe'.
- **Pulea fa'ale-aganu'u:** 'alo'ese mai fanua ua afaina; fa'aaoga le 4-tausaga fa'asolo, ma le sana, soya, brassicas, araisa; toto i luga o tuasivi / moega si'i e fa'aleleia alavai; aveese vave laau ua magumagu; aveese le palapala mai seevae, masini, ma meafaigaluega; sulu tamato i luga o le isalaelu e mafai ona pala; fa'aaoga ituaiga e fa'asa'o.
- **Puleaina o vaila'au:** leai se mea e fautuaina.

Igoa masani: La'au fa'ama'i, mala fa'ama'i o pateta, malafa'ama'i o fa'ato'aga Solanaceous.

Igoa Faasaienisi: *Ralstonia solanacearum*. E tele tuuga.
