- **Lokol kontrol:** lu mas lukluk lo nurseries an plants olowe: aotim olketa hip blo eggs o wom, plantim olketa niu kabis farawe from olo wan ,plantim narafala plant wea karem stron smel wea insek ia laekem, olsem mustards o Chinese kabis (Bok Choy) bata mas aotim an torowem olketa bifo eggs blo insek ia hatch.
- **Kemikol kontrol:** krops lo supsup gaden, usim olketa plants wea save raosim o kilim inseks olsem chillies, neem, derris, pyrethrum; lo bik gadens plantim kabis andanit lo nets, spreim Bt (*Bacillus thuringiensis*) fo kilim olketa smol wom.

**Lokol nem:** Kabis cluster caterpillar, large kabis moth (LCM), large kabis-heart caterpillar

**Saentifik Nem:** *Crocidolomia pavonana*, nem bifo hem *Crocidolomia binotalis*. Hem smol bataflae blo famili Crambidae.
