A family of about 50 genera and 2000 species, cosmopolitan but more abundant in temperate areas; 5 genera occur naturally in Australia.

Genera

Clematis - A genus of about 250 species, cosmopolitan, mainly in temperate areas; four species occur naturally in Australia. Stanley & Ross (1983).
