

Secamone lineata Blume

Family:
Apocynaceae

Blume, C.L. von (1827) *Bijdragen tot de Flora van Nederlandsch Indie* No. 7: 1051. Type: Java, Mt Salak, C. Blume: *Herbario Boiss.* BO.

Stem

A slender vine not exceeding a stem diameter of 2 cm.

Leaves

Twigs and petioles produce a milky exudate. Leaf blades about 5.5-11.5 x 2-5 cm, petioles about 1-2 cm long.

Flowers

Flowers about 13-14 mm diam. on pedicels about 12-14 mm long. Sepals lanceolate, about 1.4 mm long. Corolla lobes reflexed, lanceolate, about 7 x 1.5 mm. Staminal corona about 2 x 2 mm. fide Forster (1996).

Fruit

Seedlings

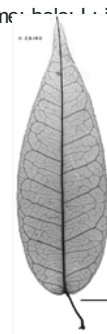

Occurs in CYP. Altitudinal range in CYP from near sea level to 250 m. Grows in monsoon forest and vine thicket. Also occurs in Malesia.
