

# *Symplocos cyanocarpa* var. *pilosa* Jessup

Family:  
**Symplocaceae**

## Stem

Flowers and fruits as a shrubby plant about 3-4 m tall.

## Leaves

Leaf blades about 8-16 x 2.5-6 cm, petioles about 0.4-0.7 cm long, grooved on the upper surface. Upper surface of the leaf blade arched between the lateral veins. Lateral veins about 7-10 on each side of the midrib, forming loops inside the blade margin.

## Flowers

Flowers about 3 mm diam. Calyx lobes about 2-2.5 mm long. Corolla about 2-3 mm long. Stamens about 20-21, filaments hairy, about 1.5-2 mm long. Pollen yellow. Style about 1-3 mm long. Disk orange, clothed in erect hairs.

## Fruit

Fruits +/- cylindrical, about 10 x 4 mm.

## Seedlings

Features not available.

## Distribution and Ecology

Endemic to NEQ, known from the Big Tableland and Mt Hartley. Altitudinal range from 200-750 m. Grows as an understory plant in upland rain forest.

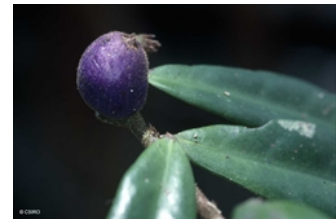
