## Family

Fabaceae

## Description

Very closely related to A. lineata, differing primarily in the following ways. Phyllode midrib central. Peduncles puberulous. Pods and seeds not seen.

### Notes

This taxon was originally described as *A. lineata* Group 1 by J.H.Maiden, *J. & Proc. Roy. Soc. New South Wales* 49: 497 (1916), but a decade later formally described as *A. centrinervia*. It was noted by B.R.Maslin, *Fl. Australia* 11A: 591 (2001) as a variant under *A. lineata* of which it may indeed represent an aberrant form. Except for the type from Parkes, N.S.W., the only other presumably naturally occurring material seen of it is from near Herries Ra., near Inglewood, Qld, collected in Oct. 1922 (*C.J.Smith 2*, BRI, NSW). 'Typical' A. lineata occurs at both Parkes and Inglewood. Although *A. centrinervia* is provisionally recognized here its taxonomic status should be reassessed in the light of a comprehensive review of *A. lineata*.
