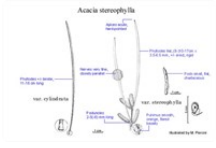

#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Restricted to the Kalbarri Natl Park area, W.A.

#### Description

Phyllodes **terete** or subterete, 11–18 cm long, 1.3–2 mm wide, with equally distinct nerves; **pulvinus** normally lacking **abaxial** ridge.

#### Habitat

Grows on sandstone cliffs and in sand over sandstone in *Acacia* shrubland.

#### Specimens
