#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Occurs from Nerren Nerren Stn SE to Tammin and Boorabbin, south-west W.A.

#### Description

Phyllodes **linear**, flat, mostly 10–17 cm long, 3–6.5 mm wide, with distinct marginal nerves; **pulvinus** often with **abaxial** ridge.

#### Habitat

Grows in sand, gravelly sand and loam, mostly on plains, in shrubland (where it is often common), scrub, mallee and woodland.

#### Specimens

W.A.: 13.5 km N of Tammin towards Korrelocking, *B.R.Maslin 4423* (PERTH); c. 89 km from Southern Cross towards Coolgardie, *M.E.Phillips WA/68 677* (PERTH); 72.4–75.6 km S of Wannoo, *M.E.Phillips WA/68 1169* (PERTH); 11.3 km SE of Morawa towards Perenjori, *M.D.Tindale 2768* (K, NSW, PERTH).
