Family

Fabaceae

Distribution

Occurs from near Williams and Narrogin SE to Katanning, W.A.

Description

Subshrub, **erect** or sometimes sprawling, normally many-stemmed, sometimes spreading by subterranean runners. **Branchlets** densely **puberulous-hirsutellous**. Pinnules **oblong** to **oblong-obovate**, flat or with slightly **recurved** margins, excentrically **apiculate**, \pm thick, grey-green, densely hirsutellous; **gland** on **petiole**, absent from **rachis**. Spikes **cylindrical**, bright golden. Seeds **longitudinal** to **oblique**; **aril** 1/4–1/2 length of seed.

Habitat

Grows in sandy gravel on laterite hills in open woodland.

W.A.: c. 5 km N of Nyabing towards Kukerin, *B.R.Maslin 5843* (AD, K, MEL, MEXU, NSW, PERTH); 126 km N of Kojonup on Albany Hwy, *M.D.Tindale 362 & B.R.Maslin* (K, PERTH, NSW).
